## Authorization to transport explained:

The club will send to Quebec members, a personalized letter for the SQ so that you can apply for an ATT or renew your PAL.

Even though C-42 is now in force, you need an Authorization to Transport (ATT) ([autorisation de transport AT](#)) to bring any handguns from Quebec to the club.

The following procedure seems to be the best process to follow:

1. Fill out the usual R.C.M.P. form (5490/5490f) for an ATT request. [Copy can be found here.](#)
2. Sign it, scan it and then transform to PDF. Alternatively you can FAX both documents to the S.Q.
3. Write an email to: [permis@surete.qc.ca](mailto:permis@surete.qc.ca)
4. The email should contain as attachments, both PDF files (completed, signed form and the letter from VKHGC) with a message that reads pretty much as follows:

5. You can request an electronic copy of the ATT by email.
6. So far the turnaround time is faster than 3 weeks.
7. For your PAL the SQ should advise you that they need proof of club membership. The document attached will do just that.

### Hints for filling out the ATT request form:

Section A: enter full name and address

Section B: enter all restricted/prohibited guns you plan on bringing to the club.

Section C: check box "m" and enter Vankleek Hill Gun Club in "m1" and 64759 in "m2"

Section D: enter the transport date from today until the end date on your SQ letter. (Usually Oct 31 of next year)

Time of transport is from 0:00 to 23:59

Frequency is daily (for target shooting)

Section E: Transport route is from place where guns are stored (usually your home) to the club. (address 2150 Barb Rd, St Eugene, Ont., K0B 1P0)
